

## HPCA Meeting Minutes March 4, 2025

1. Meeting started at 7:04p.m.
2. Agenda Approval; No changes to Agenda; Moved by Susan, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Linda. Approved.
3. January 7, 2025, Meeting Minutes: No change. Approval Moved by Linda, 2<sup>nd</sup> by James.
4. Councillor's Report
  - a) **Update on Community Building:** The tender for the construction of the Building now closed. Ben to follow up with Phil as to start of construction. Miles confirmed that there will be pool access this summer.
  - b) **Property standards By-law:** Miles indicated that strengthened regulations regarding waste management are expected in August.
  - c) **One sided Winter Parking:** Continued resistance from City Officials to Heron Park's request for one-sided winter parking on neighbourhood streets. Miles suggested that the Association work with John to arrange a meeting with the appropriate City Officials. City requires that 2/3 of residents on a street agree (via a petition) to changes to on-street parking. Miles is willing to e-mail and call residents in advance of any door-to-door canvassing that members do.

Susan mentioned that there is a flyer, members can download and print from the FB page, that can be put on cars to request that the driver park on one side (avoid parking across from other parked cars). Susan also shared her positive experience of speaking to drivers to bring awareness of the problems of parking on both sides.
  - d) **Mural on wall at Timmermans Park:** it appears that the deadline was missed. Members were unable to get a response from the owner in time.

Questions for Councillor's Office: There were no questions for the Councillor's Office. (Note: Miles will be out of the office for the next two months. Catlyne (Katlin?) will be his replacement.)

### 5. Other Business

Tania spoke about the **Clemintine Food Pantry**, sharing information about the continuing need for donations. Susan has since posted information about how the community can assist the Clementine Food Pantry on the HPCA FB page as well as sharing it via the group e-mail.
